Regarding the "Double Grid" procedure we are using all agreed while it is working well drivers are spending far too much time just sitting in their cars, J Smith told the meeting the South ramp was the starting point and it was always going to be moved to the North ramp when the area at the top of the North ramp was enlarged, D Walker advised drawings were being done now and when the time is right gridding will take place there and drivers will only have to grid up once then go straight on to the track by using the South ramp. All agreed this would be great.

M Bully gave an outline of the new WASCC Scrutiny audit policy, Tess Taylor asked what would happen if a car was given a pre season audit by a Scrutineer not on the WASCC list?, G Edwards asked what grade of license is needed to do audits, Tess advised a bronze license is needed, much discussion took place.

G Edwards gave the meeting an update on the national front, OLT's are being reviewed, he is not winning on the point of trying to have reverse grids being used in State rounds even though reverse grids are used in national rounds.

M Bully gave the meeting an update on the infield pit area and advised the track would be closed from approximately December to April with the calendar being finished in Oct/Nov.

G Edwards asked if the Wanneroo 300 is going ahead, M Bully advised yes it will be held in November.
